The newsroom team produces broadcasts, television programmes and online media in Arabic and English, including on different social media platforms.</p> <p>To broadcast via shortwave and on satellite television is costly and requires external support as well and this is the second biggest cost item.</p> <p>To make the work possible, the organisation spends money on a lean management team and an office.</p>
